John 9: 1-13, 29

- v.1 1. Given to ones without human merit.
(...a man which was blind from his birth.)
- v.3 2. Given to glorify God.
(...but that the works of God should be made manifest in him.)
- v.4 3. Given to reveal Christ as the Son of God.
(I must work the works of Him that sent me, while)
- v.4 4. Given in the time of man's opportunity to know God.
(while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work.)
- v.5 5. Given to bring light to man's darkened pathway.
(As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world.)
- v.13 6. Given to reproof the unbelieving.
(They brought to the Pharisees him that aforetime was blind.)
- v.39 7. Given that men might see Jesus.
(...that they which see not might see;)
