

Christ In Control
John 11: 6-15, 23

- v.6 1. God's wisdom exceeds a believer's awareness.
(...He abode two days still in the same place where He was.)
- v.6 2. God's wisdom exceeds a believer's understanding.
- v.7 3. God's wisdom exceeds a believer's perception of time.
(Then after that saith He to His disciples, Let us go into Judea again.)
- v.8-10 4. God's wisdom exceeds a believer's fears.
(the Jews of late sought to stone thee; ...)
- v.14 5. God's wisdom exceeds a believer's bounds.
(Then said Jesus unto them plainly, Lazarus is dead.)
Man had reached his bounds, but Jesus had not.
This day of knowledge puts its emphasis on man's gain of knowledge. Buy wisdom, sell it not.
- v.15 6. God's wisdom exceeds a believer's unbelief.
(And I am glad for your sakes that I was not there, to the intent ye may believe; nevertheless let us go to him.)
- v.23 7. God's wisdom exceeds a believer's capacities.
(Jesus saith unto her, Thy brother shall rise again.)
