

Christ, Supreme in His Choosing  
John 6: 69-71

- v.69, 1. Not all who follow believe.  
70 (And we believe and are sure thou art the Christ, he Son of the living God.)  
(Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, ...)
- v.70 2. Not all who choose are chosen,  
(Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil?)
- v.71 3. Not all who follow are loyal.  
(...for he it was that should betray Him, being one of the twelve.)
- v.70 4. Followers of the devil have clear distinctive to Christ.  
(and one of you is a devil?)
- v.70 5. Evil's intention cannot be concealed from Christ.
- v.71 6. God is greater than man's uprising.  
(He spake of Judas Iscariot, the son of Simon: for he it was that should betray  
Him, being one of the twelve.)
7. Christ's rule is unbreakable.
