

Failing to See Jesus  
John 9: 3-41

V 3 1) In all of life's events the overriding issue is the revealing of the Son of God.  
Even in the issue of sin.

(Jesus answered, Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him.)

this man was a sinner, but sin didn't cause his blindness

v.4 2) There is a season for Christ's work.

(I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work.)

v. 4 3) A time does come upon the earth when seeing light is removed. (not cut off, but removed.)

(I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work.)

v. 5 4) Jesus is the light that precludes the darkness.

(As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world.)

v. 7, 35 5) Obedience (believing) the light of Christ brings forth light.

(And said unto him, Go, wash in the pool of Siloam, (which is by interpretation, Sent.) He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing.)

(Jesus heard that they had cast him out; and when he had found him, he said unto him, Dost thou believe on the Son of God?)

v. 39 6) Judgment shall visit those not responding to the light of Christ.

(And Jesus said, For judgment I am come into this world, that they which see not might see; and that they which see might be made blind.)

v. 41 7) For those refusing the light of Jesus, their sin remains.

(Jesus said unto them, If ye were blind, ye should have no sin: but now ye say, We see; therefore your sin remaineth.)
