- v.13 1. The one with truth has no argument.
(And he that was healed wist not who it was:)
- v.13 2. The one blessed of truth has no reason to bind truth. God does that.
(wist not who it was: for Jesus had conveyed Himself away, ...)
- v.14 3. The one meeting truth has a desire for more truth.
(Afterward Jesus findeth him in the temple, and said unto him, Behold,)
- v.14 4. Truth gained is irreversible.
(...Behold, thou art made whole:sin)
- v.14 5. Truth's liberty is forgiveness.
(sin no more, lest a ...)
- v.14 6. Truth's liberty is absolute, complete.
(thou art made whole:)
- v.14 7. Truth's liberty is to be continued in.
(sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto thee.)
