(He restoreth my soul;)
- v.3 7. I can trust His righteous name.

- v.4 8. I can trust in His accompaniment wherever I am in Him.  
(Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death,)(for thou art with me;)
- v.4 9. I can trust in His defense.  
(I will fear no evil;)
- v.4 10. I can trust in His faithful hand to hold me on course.  
(thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.)
- v.5 11. I can walk with God wherever He leads.  
(Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies;)  
No one can take me from His presence, nor His will.
- v.5 12. I can rejoice in His supply and bountiful care for me.  
(thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over.)
- v.6 13. I can enjoy His present work of goodness and mercy.  
(Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life;)
- v.6 14. I can joyfully await the glory that is to come.  
(and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.)
